


Dear Parent,

Typical Day at Camp

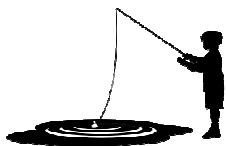

About Jamestown 4-H Educational Center

The Jamestown 4-H Educational Center began as one of the state's first regional summer camps for 4-H'ers. It is composed of 16 acres, wooded and open, and borders the James River.

Registration

-Youth must reach their ninth birthday between October 1, 2011 and September 30, 2012 and must not have reached their fourteenth birthday before October 1, 2012.

-Registration is limited and filled on a first-come, first served basis. **Camp registration closes when all spots are filled or on June 1, 2012, whichever comes first.**

-Separate registration must be completed for each child. Feel free to make copies of the registration form.

-Once we have received a completed registration accompanied by the non-refundable \$50 deposit or full payment, you will receive a packet of all required forms in March. These forms must be completed and returned to our office **no later than June 1, 2012.** *Please note that all forms must be submitted in order to assign all classes/funshops.

- If forms and final balance are not in by June 1, you lose your spot in camp.

Camp Fee

Early Bird Rate: \$245.00. A *\$50.00 deposit is due with registration form. \$195.00 balance due by April 30th **\$50.00 Deposit is non-refundable.**

Regular Rate:\$255.00. A *\$50.00 deposit is due with registration form. \$ 205.00 balance due by June 1st. **\$50.00 Deposit is non-refundable.**

-The Camp Fee includes meals, lodging, transportation to and from camp, class/funshop supplies and a camp t-shirt.

-If camper is wait-listed, deposit is returned & camper will be notified if a spot opens.

***Refund Policy-** Receive a full refund less \$50.00 if you cancel in writing by June 1, 2012. No refunds after June 1, 2012. *May take up to 8 weeks for a refund to be processed.*

Return Check Fee- There will be a \$35.00 return check fee payable in cash, money order or cashier's check.
