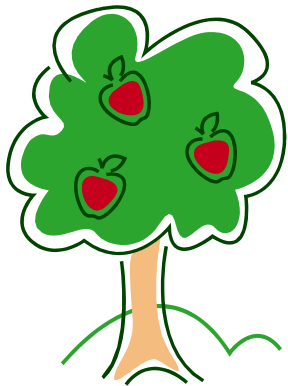


Fruit Tree Pruning Workshop

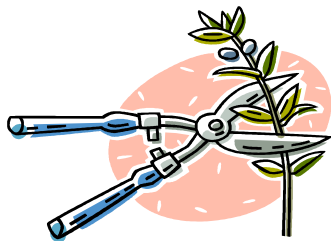
