 Junior Camp is open to all youth 9-13 (at least 9 years old by September 30, 2012) Youth whose 13th birthday is after 1-1-12 but before October 1, 2012 may enroll as a camper or a Counselor in Training. Youth who are 13 (as of 1-1-12) must apply to attend as Counselor in Training. This introductory program is designed for young teens interested in leadership training. 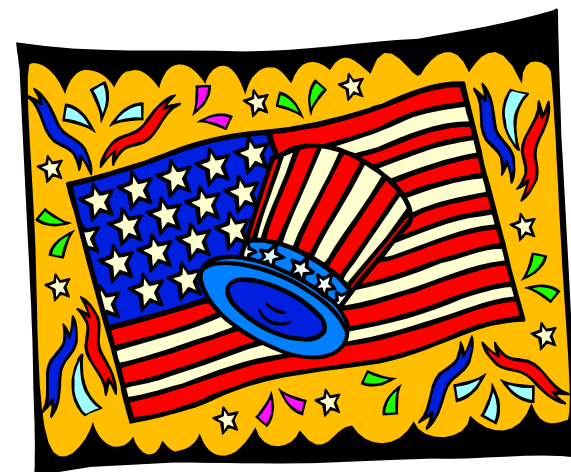
