REGISTRATION PROCESS:

Registration begins February 1, 2012. Registration forms may be mailed to the Extension office, and will not be processed until Feb. 1st, when they will be opened in the order they were received. In-person registrations will have priority over those in the mail. Each camper must have a completed registration and a \$50 non-refundable deposit PER CAMP.

In March, you will be sent a packet with additional details, directions to the camp, and more forms to complete, including one for selection of classes.

Please note: Registrations are accepted until camp is filled, however, classes are assigned on a first-come first-served basis. So, register early and return your packet of forms quickly to avoid disappointment.

REFUND POLICY:

All refund requests must be in writing.

There will be a \$50 non-refundable processing fee per camp. The remaining balance will be refunded until May 10, after-which no refunds will be given except in cases of sickness (with a doctor's note) or emergency (evaluated on a case by case basis) or if there are still interested people on a waiting list who can cover the costs.

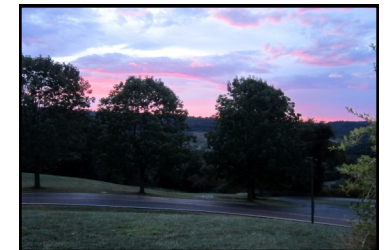
