SUBJECT: Recertification Programs

Virginia Cooperative Extension will conduct two private pesticide applicator trainings in December for categories 90 (*Food, Fiber, Forestry Products and Commodity Production Pest Control*) and 91 (*Ornamental Pest Control*). These classes are designed to meet the educational requirements for maintaining a private pesticide applicator's license. You should have received a letter from the Virginia Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (VDACS) recently informing you of your educational credits and whether you need to attend additional pesticide education classes to complete re-certification requirements.

If you received a letter from the Virginia Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (VDACS) notifying you that your license expires this December, **you must attend a recertification program before December 31, 2010.**

Private Applicator Categories

- 90 *Food, Fiber, Forestry Products and Commodity Production Pest Control*: for use of restricted-use pesticides in the production of agricultural crops, livestock, or forest products. This includes the use of pesticides to control vertebrate pests of livestock. It also includes fumigation and chemigation applications.
- 91 *Ornamental Pest Control*: for use of restricted-use pesticides to control ornamental pests in nurseries and greenhouses. It includes fumigation and chemigation applications.

From King George County: We are located on Route 3 just east of the Courthouse in The Village Center. Our office is located on the front side of the building adjacent to the woods.

From the South: From I-95 take Carmel Church, Route 207 Exit (Exit 104). Follow 207 and US 301 North. At intersection of US 301 and Route 3 turn left on Route 3. Go approximately 2 miles to the Village Center on the right. Turn right into Village Center. Our office is located on the end of the building next to the woods.

The Northern Virginia Area and Fredericksburg: Take I-95 south to exit 130 (towards Fredericksburg). Go east on Route 3 for approximately 20 miles. You will enter King George and see Union Bank and Trust on the left. Just beyond the bank is the Village Center. Our office is located on the front side of the building adjacent to the woods.
